General GSL Information Versions 2.4 & 3.0

Grave **S**ite **L**ayout has similarities in both versions in the manner an end-user interfaces with each program.

Edit

<u>Edit</u> screen is used primarily to alter existing information. Edit is a term used to alter the existing designation. At no time is a grave site to be deleted (removed) from the list after a number has been assigned.

Delete

The <u>ONLY</u> time a grave site can be deleted is before the site is numbered by the program. Opening and closing the *Edit* screen does not number grave sites. This is a safe area to review information entered.

A grave site with no Grave ID can be removed (deleted).

Grave ID

A sequential grave ID number is set to each grave site when *Create Grave Sites* screen is closed. There is no way to re-index grave sites if a user removes a numbered grave site. In this event an error message is displayed when *Create Grave Sites* screen is closed.

Entering Grave Sites Manually

If a user clicks on the open record area of the *Edit* screen, a new blank record is created. If the user does not enter information into this record, the user MUST delete the open record. When *Create Grave Sites* screen is closed this open record might be numbered. In most cases, an open record will not be numbered and will stop the automatic numbering with an error message. Since there are no grave site descriptors, this blank grave site may not appear in the Edit area to be resolved.

CSR does not warranty user's entering grave sites manually. The *Create Grave Sites* screen will accept single entries for additional grave sites.
